Residents hang out their windows chatting to their neighbours, and at lunch the fish restaurants grill their fare on the street.

We suggest you a visit to this typical village having a nice grilled fish meal in a Tavern , facing the river.

You can visit the tiled houses, the fishermen sewing fishing nets, the community tank that is the meeting point of the women of this fishing community and taste a delicious fish caught in the day and charcoal grilled.
